Following a brief history of open-heart surgery, this presentation will discuss: the handoff of the patient from the surgical team to the ICU nursing team; continuous monitoring of the patient's vitals with x-rays, continuous labs, and other procedures; monitoring the ventilator and the endotracheal and oral gastric tubes; maintaining the chest tubes and foley catheter; and many other tasks including pain management and preventing infections and edema. In summary, helping patients transition from the operating room back to their homes and loving families.
