Dr. Hummel is an electrophysiologist at Ohio State's Wexner Medical Center. Since 2006, he has held academic appointments as a professor of clinical internal medicine and as the director of electrophysiology research at Ohio State. He previously served as the director of the clinical electrophysiology animal lab at the University of Michigan Medical Center before becoming the Division of Cardiology's section chief at Riverside Methodist Hospital.

Dr. Hummel specializes in the treatment of cardiac arrhythmias with primary interests that include left atrial appendage closure and atrial fibrillation (AFib). For nearly a decade, Dr. Hummel has partnered with Dr. Vadim Fedorov to identify the hidden sources of AFib, which will drive the development of new treatments.

A graduate of the University of Virginia School of Medicine, Dr. Hummel completed his residency and fellowships in cardiovascular medicine and cardiac electrophysiology at Johns Hopkins Hospital.
